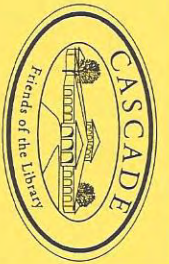

Type of Book	Price	Possible Exceptions
Hardcover	\$3.00	If DJ is missing, box or subtract \$1 If new or hot seller, price at \$4 or \$5
Paperback, reg.	\$1.50	
Paperback, large	\$2.00	If original price <\$10, price at \$1.50 If current year, price at \$3.00
Large, coffee-table	\$3.00 - \$5.00	Some might be higher
Cookbooks	\$2.00 - \$5.00	
Little books	\$1.00 - \$2.00	Check original prices
Art books	Prices vary	Most should be put aside for research
VHS tapes	\$.25	
Books on cassette tape	\$.25	
Books on CDs or DVDs	\$2.00 - \$3.00	
CDs Music	\$1.00	Can be higher if newer or hot seller
Movies on DVDs	\$2.00	
Oldies	\$.25
