# **United for Libraries Keynote Speaker**

The keynote speaker was Beth Nawalinski, Executive Director of United for Libraries, who provided an overview of the UFL website with special emphasis on access for Michigan public library Friends and trustees.

Here is some important information from Shannon White, Library Development Manager, about access to the UFL website:



The Library of Michigan (LM) provides statewide membership for all Michigan public libraries in United for Libraries (UFL), a division of the American Library Association. This means that library Friends across the state can access members only resources provided by UFL.

This year UFL upgraded their online platform to allow individuals to access the resources with their own unique login and password. As a Library Friend you can now create your own account and unique login. To set up your account follow these steps:

- 1. Visit www.ala.org/united
- Click on the STATEWIDE ACCESS FIND YOUR STATE blue bar
- 3. Scroll down to Michigan
- 4. Click Register to create your own profile
- **5.** For future access you simply login to your account under MICHIGAN

- Online access to The Voice for America's Libraries issued bi-monthly. Current and archived copies can be accessed online on the UFL site.
- Toolkits to help Friends of the Library obtain tax-exempt status, set up online bookselling, and understand the roles of Friends, Trustees, and Library Directors
- Monthly membership forums and online discussion groups to share ideas and learn from other library friends across the country.

#### **FOML Merit Award**

The FOML Awards Committee reviewed seven applications for the special 2020 Merit Award for a Michigan Friends group that carried out a successful project during the time when libraries were closed to onsite visits because of the COVID epidemic. Congratulations to the winner of the award, the Friends of the Charlotte Community Library, for its project involving senior activity bags.



Seventy senior activity bags containing such items as a boxed jigsaw puzzle were delivered to the local Meals on Wheels organization for distribution to senior citizens in Eaton County who were serviced by their program. The bags were given to seniors at the time of their next meal delivery. The Friends believed it was important to reach out to seniors at a time when they were being overlooked.

The Friends of the Charlotte Community Library will receive a \$400 award from FOML for their outstanding project.

FOML has been presenting the Merit Award to Friends groups annually based on completion of a project which was successfully completed the previous year.
