Talk About Friends at the Alpena County Library

FOML held its third Talk About Friends meeting of 2023 on Friday, October 6, at the Alpena County Library. Charles Hanson, FOML Treasurer, attended the meeting and coordinated the discussion among the 14 participants. Clare Membiela, Library Law Consultant at the Library of Michigan, made her presentation to the group by Zoom, emphasizing the best practices and principles for Friends groups. She pointed out the organizational structure for Friends as a 501(c)3 or as a Michigan nonprofit corporation under LARA. She noted that Friends groups must follow the rules and regulations of licensing and legal requirements when presenting fundraising events such as raffles. Clare also stressed the importance of knowing how public libraries are organized in Michigan (city, township, and district) and the importance of being aware of the respective roles and responsibilities of the library trustees, the director and staff, and the Friends of the library.

The meeting was another opportunity for Friends from different libraries to exchange ideas, talk about their successful fundraising projects, and work together on solving problems that Friends groups sometimes encounter. The meeting evaluations were positive. One person remarked, "I sat with people from other areas and learned a lot."
